

PENTAX DIGITAL SLRS

Plastic or metal - What is best?

When travelling a lighter plastic camera may seem a better solution, but this need to be treated with great care to avoid breakage. Inexpensive Digital SLR's supplied with a twin lens kit are particularly vulnerable to breaking when the longer plastic mount lens is attached. So care is needed to avoid this. The lighter plastic bodied cameras can also be difficult to hold still in poor light.

Some Digital SLR's, such as Pentax are made with a Stainless Steel Chassis and S/Steel Body and Lens Mounts. This makes for a stronger more durable outfit and the lenses also tend to be sharper than their plastic counter parts. The durable nature of this method of construction does make the camera heavier to carry, but easier to hold still.

Sigma and Pentax lenses are made with stainless steel mounts, making them ideal for school use.

How many lenses should you have for your Digital SLR?

If you enjoy changing lenses as many as you can afford. My personal experience has been that having one lens with sufficient range for all my normal photography is a much better solution than having two or more lenses. The reason for this is twofold: I find that having to change lens causes a delay and many great pictures are lost. I also prefer carrying just the one lens and the one set of filters, so that I can be ready for pictures as the opportunity arises.

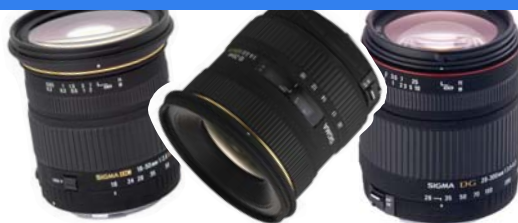
